## FOR THE PRIESTS AND NUNS

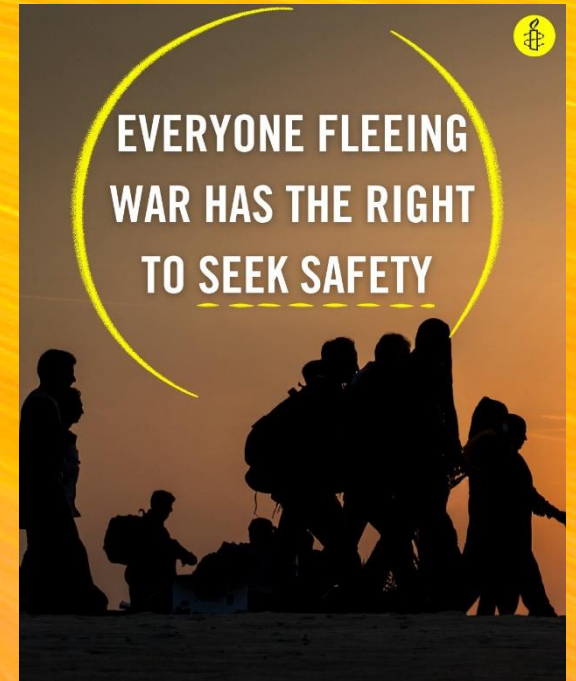
*Let us pray that men and women grow

## FOR THOSE FLEEING THEIR OWN COUNTRIES

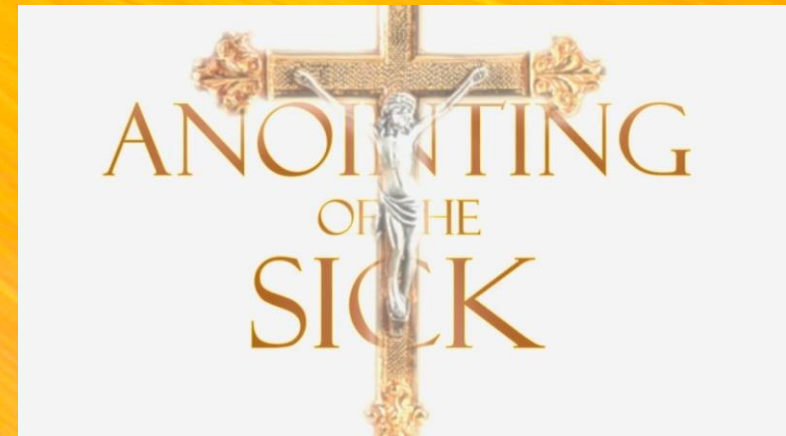
*Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger be welcomed and looked after in their host countries.*
