### English

Our text this term will be Old Bear by Jane Hissey. Whilst reading and investigating this book we will practice writing simple sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. We will build these up to write a short narrative. In addition, we will the sounds we already know

- · Identify and name a variety of everyday materials.

- Observe and record the changes which take place in Autumn.

#### Creation and Covenant

We begin with the topic 'Creation and Covenant' where we will encounter the God who creates and calls all people. We will explore all that comes from God, The Creation story and learn about the call of Abraham and Moses through the Old Testament.



## Geography

As Geographers, we will be finding taking a closer look into our local area of Bestwood. We will complete this unit with a short walk around the area.

#### We will be learning:

- About aerial photographs
- About human and physical features of our school grounds and surrounding environment
- simple compass directions (NESW)
- how to use a map and simple compass directions to plan a route around the school grounds.
- basic map symbols and begin to understand the need for a key.

### Music

Our Music specialist teachers will come into Year I once a week. Their lessons this half term will focus on Old-School Hip-Hop. They will learn the words to the rap 'Hey You' and learn the difference between song and rap. We will also be thinking about pulse, rhythm and pitch and how they work together.

PE

This half term, our PE specialist teachers will be focusing on learning new skills through Cricket. We will learn how to do under and over arm throws thinking about our hand and foot positions when throwing and catching.

### **RSHE**

Families and Relationships We will be looking at respecting one another and knowing that following the Sacraments can help us to develop healthy relationships. We will also focus on the importance of forgiveness and reconciliation. Finally, we will be using drama to help understand about bullying, including cyber-bullying.
